I am writing to you to say that I strongly object to the way that Highways England has gone about selecting its preferred option for the A5036 Port of Liverpool Access Scheme. I am concerned that its proposals:

- Will destroy Rimrose Valley Country Park and the flora and fauna contained within
- Will sever links between communities and people
- Will massively increase carbon emissions and noise pollution in what is the last, remaining open green space in the area
- Will not address congestion issues in the area in the long-term
- Are in conflict with the Government's own 25 year Environment Plan
